Clinical Counselors provide short-term, solution-focused, non-psychiatric individual, couples, and group clinical intervention for eligible military personnel and their families.

Duties

- Conduct intake, screening, assessment, and referral of clients as appropriate.
 - Establish an individual treatment plan outlining the goals of treatment with the client
 - Provide individual, couples and group counseling.
 - Offer prevention and education programs and services based on client needs
 - Maintain all counseling case documentation in accordance with all applicable policies, laws and instructions
 - Provide clinical services and case management for clients regarding domestic abuse and sexual assault cases
- Other duties as assigned.

Required Qualifications:

- Master's Degree in Social Work from a graduate School of Social Work accredited by the Council on Social Work education, **OR** a Master's Degree in Marriage and Family Therapy from a graduate program accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for Marriage and Family Therapy, **OR** a Doctoral degree in Psychology from a program accredited by the American Psychological Association.
- Clinical license/certification to provide clinical services as an independent practitioner (Acceptable licenses are: LCSW, LICSW, LMFT or Licensed Clinical Psychologist (LCP)).
- A minimum of two years of full-time, post-masters supervised clinical experience.
- Prior to hire, selected candidate must have three letter of reference from three clinical providers who have direct knowledge of the clinical provider's clinical practice within the previous two years. The letters must be provided by licensed clinical social workers, marriage and family therapists, psychologists, or psychiatrists.
- Two years of experience working in the field of child abuse and domestic abuse.

Desired Qualifications:

- Professional experience working with military families or personal military lifestyle experience.
- Knowledge of the difficulties of adjusting to general life stresses as well as the stresses associated with military life style. Experience in providing short-term counseling for these issues.
- Knowledge of local community and military resources appropriate for clients.
- Experience in performing accurate assessments of the client's presenting problem and developing effective treatment plans for identified problems
- Experience in working with clients affected by different forms of abuse including domestic and sexual assault.
- Experience in maintaining standard documentation required for clinical casework.
- Experience in intervening in crisis situations using sound professional judgment, ethical practice, and common sense.
