Required Qualifications:

- A minimum of a Master's Degree in Social Work from a graduate School of Social Work accredited by the Council on Social Work education; OR a Master's Degree in Marriage and Family

Therapy from a graduate program accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for Marriage and Family Therapy; OR a Doctoral degree in Psychology from a program accredited by the American Psychological Association.

- Clinical license/certification to provide clinical services as an independent practitioner (Acceptable licenses are: LCSW, LICSW, LMFT or Licensed Clinical Psychologist (LCP).
- A minimum of two years of full-time clinical experience.
- Two years of experience in working in the areas of domestic violence and child abuse. Experience pre-licensure or post-licensure will meet this requirement.

Desired Qualifications:

- Professional experience working with military families or personal military lifestyle experience.
- Knowledge of the difficulties of adjusting to general life stresses as well as those resulting from the requirements of military life and experience providing short-term counseling for those issues.
- Knowledge of standard documentation requirements for clinical casework.
- Knowledge of other available military and community referral resources appropriate for client.
